Pre-Arrival Information for New Undergraduate Students (2024-25 Intake)

CONFIRM ADMISSIONS STATUS

If you are holding a conditional offer, please submit the required documents as soon as available to confirm your fulfilment of all conditions as stated on your offer letter.

SUBMISSION OF ACADEMIC DOCUMENTS

All admitted students are required to upload a scanned colour image of the official <u>admissions-related documents</u> before program registration and present the original documents for verification upon arrival to campus. You may check your document submission status in the "Offer Status" section under "My Applications" page on the <u>Online Application System</u>. An email notification will be sent to you specifying the procedures for submission of the original documents in due course.

REGISTRATION & TUITION FEE

Program registration will be conducted online this year between mid-July to end of August. After your admissions status has been confirmed, you will receive a registration notification email from the Academic Registry with details on registration schedule, tuition fee payment instruction, scholarship disbursement, student account activation, etc.

STUDENT VISA ARRANGEMENT (FOR NON-LOCAL STUDENTS)

The Immigration Department of HKSAR has implemented "e-Visa" arrangement. We will send out the approved visas to offer confirmed applicants by email starting from end of June. Conditional offer holders whose final results are still forthcoming are urged to submit the final documents soon as they become available. For GCEAL students with exams in this May/June, we will deliver the visa package to you electronically in mid-late August after your offer has been confirmed.

Please note that all Non-local students must have a valid visa to study at HKUST. Students are required to upload their activated visa label and landing slip to Online Registration Form upon arrival in Hong Kong.

ARRIVAL TO CAMPUS

New undergraduate students with valid hall offers can check in your dormitory starting from <u>19</u> August (Non-local students) and 29 August (Local students).
